

FEE STRUCTURE FOR PERMIT APPLICATIONS TO DENMARK

When applying for a work or study and residence permit to Denmark from abroad, the following fees will be payable:

1. First of all there will be a fee payable to the Danish Agency for International Recruitment and Integration in Copenhagen for processing your application. The fee amount will vary depending on the type of permit you are applying for. This fee is paid directly to the Danish Agency for International Recruitment and Integration either with a credit card through the payment portal of their website (recommended) or as an international bank wire transfer. It is important that you pay this fee before your appointment at VFS Global. Don't forget to bring your receipt. 2. When submitting an application for a residence permit to Denmark through a Diplomatic Mission abroad there will be an additional fee of \$285 payable to the Danish Ministry of Foreign Affairs. This fee will be payable through VFS Global, when you go for your appointment. From our local website for Danish diplomatic missions in Canada we have posted our fee schedule:

3. Finally VFS Global will charge their service fee of \$45 for receiving your application and obtaining your biometric features. In addition you will be charged a courier fee to send your passport, application and biometric features to the Danish Consulate General in Toronto for case handling, as well as for the return of your passport to your residence (2 x \$25). In the event that you have not brought the required photocopies for your appointment, VFS Global offers optional copying services for \$1 per copy. You are also given the option of purchasing their SMS service for an additional \$3. For this fee you will receive a text from VFS Global when your passport has been verified at the Danish Consulate General and is being returned to you via UPS courier. Fees under point 2 and 3 are both payable through VFS Global, when you go for your appointment, payable with debit or credit card (Amex not accepted).
