You must collect copies of all required documents in the mandatory checklist **before** you send the application package to the Danish authorities or submit it to the Danish Embassy in Ottawa or one of the Danish consulates in Edmonton, Halifax, Montreal, St John's, Toronto, Vancouver or Winnipeg. Failure to submit all the required documents will result in delays or rejection of your application.
